## Car Parking and Dogs on the playground concerns.

Dear Parent/Guardians,

I have been approached over the last few days and weeks by a number of concerned parents/guardians and local residents about a number of cars parked dangerously during the 'drop off' and 'pick up' time of the school day. Whilst we appreciate that parking is extremely difficult around school, can we please remind drivers of the following issues/concerns –

- Please do NOT park on the yellow zig-zag lines at any point throughout the day. The lines are there to provide a passing point and keep traffic moving.
- Please do not block the driveways of local residents both on Tanyfron Road and St Albans Road. They have the right to gain access to their property at all times.
- Please be mindful at the top of Tanyfron Road where the pavement comes to an end. Please ensure that parents/guardians have appropriate access to continue their journey in the safest possible manner.

### **Dogs on the playground**

As above, a number of parents/guardians have approached me about the number of dogs still entering school grounds either on the school yard on a lead or being carried through school grounds by their owner. Can we please ask that all parents/guardians who walk their dog to school to drop off/collect their child(ren) do not bring their dog(s) onto the school grounds and yard. Can we politely ask that dogs do not come down the pathway from St Albans Road down to the forest school area.

As I'm sure you appreciate on both issues the Health & Safety of pupils is my main priority along with the governing body. We are currently working with the local authority, community council and Police community support team to monitor the issues and I will keep you updated of any developments once I receive them.
