## Coronavirus / Covid-19 Update – March 20<sup>th</sup> 2020

Dear Parent/Guardians,

I wish to confirm arrangements moving forward from today. As we are all aware today will be the last day for the majority of pupils until further notice. I can also confirm that in line with national guidance Dragons Daycare will also close from 5.30pm today. Whilst the immediate future remains uncertain as previously communicated staff will be providing work over the next few weeks whilst we wait further guidance. All pupils who have returned their HWB permission forms will now have had received log on details for online learning.

A separate communication will be sent out later today with a parent/guardian guide to accessing the HWB online platform. Staff will be uploading learning activities on a Monday and be available throughout the week to offer support.

As stated by the national government schools are going to remain open with a purpose of supporting 'key frontline workers' with childcare. We are now in a position to confirm that school will remain open for these parents/guardians between 08.55am and 3.00pm every weekday.

The local authority have confirmed that the list of key workers are -

- health workers – all those employed within the NHS
- Education staff who work in schools and settings
- blue light / emergency service officers
- social care workers
- supermarket delivery drivers
- prison officers and other prison staff
- probation service staff

For parents/guardians who we have been informed meet this criteria we will be sending you a separate communication with further details to see if we can meet and support your requirements. This communication will be sent via the SEESAW APP and will be with you by 09.30am this morning. Should you feel you are in one of these categories and do not receive a communication please make contact with school.

At this difficult time can we thank all parents/guardians for their support this week and encourage everyone to stay safe and well and follow all the latest government guidelines to help minimise and prevent the spread of Coronavirus
