## Coronavirus / Covid-19 Update – June 12<sup>th</sup> 2020

Dear Parent/Guardians,

I write to you today providing a brief update of the current situation before the weekend and the publication of our provisional timetable for the reopening of school.

### Key Worker Booking Forms

Can I thank all parents/guardians who have completed and returned their form to school. It has certainly helped us with the planning stage of the process. For any parents/guardians who are yet to return them to school can I ask you do so as a matter of urgency.

### Nursery Provision

**The local authority has informed us that the reopening of schools will NOT include provision for Nursery. Children of key worker parents/guardians will still be able access the key worker childcare should it be required. Now confirmation has been issued, as stated in previous correspondences, we will now begin to look at an alternative transition program for pupils starting Reception in September.**

### Welsh Government Guidance

On Wednesday local authorities, schools and the wider community were issued with guidance from Welsh Government on the reopening of schools. The document, named ***Keep Education Safe: Operational guidance for schools and settings (COVID-19)*** will be paramount to our planning over the next few days, weeks and months.
