Coronavirus Update – Sunday 25th October

Dear Parents/Guardians,

I write to you this afternoon to clarify the announcement from earlier today and confirm arrangements for all pupils and parents/guardians moving forward as school has been made aware of a number of social media posts/discussions which are circulating.

I can confirm that over the weekend Ysgol Tanyfron received confirmation of a positive test. In light of this, we have worked with Public Health Wales, the Test, Track and Protect team and the local authority this morning to clarify all the arrangements. Now those discussions are concluded I can confirm the following information.

Whole School Guidance

- All parents/guardians have received a 'General letter case in Educational Setting' via SEESAW, school website and/or school APP.
- All families within the year4/5 class bubble have been contacted separately by school with further information specific to being named as a 'close contact'. (Schools letter contact of confirmed case)
- The information shared by school is what we can legally say at this time in relation to data protection and GDPR guidelines.
- All other staff and pupil members can return to school as planned on **MONDAY 2nd NOVEMBER**

Year 4/5 class bubble

- A positive test has been confirmed in the year 4/5 class bubble.
- The year 4/5 class bubble will now need to self-isolate for a **14 day** period. They will return to school on **FRIDAY 6th NOVEMBER 9.00am.**

Whilst school is officially on the half term holidays, I can confirm that for all other staff and pupil's school will open as planned on **Monday 2nd November.** Dragons Daycare will be open over the half term holidays as normal and for any additional information required please contact Katie and the team direct.

I appreciate the news of a confirmed case will have come as a shock to many. I ask that all parents/guardians not just those in year 4/5 remain vigilant for COVID symptoms and follow the guidance shared on the Public Health Wales letter shared earlier today.

To try and allay any fears a staff member will be in school tomorrow **MONDAY 26th OCTOBER** between 08.30am and 10.00am to answer any questions any parent/guardian may have. Class teachers will be checking there SEESAW accounts but please be mindful they may not be able to respond promptly due to being on half term.
