Dear Parent/Guardians,


As we approach the Christmas holidays, I write to you to update you on a number of events, which have or are due to take place before Christmas.

Coronavirus Update

Following on from my previous correspondence regarding COVID-19 we are now starting to see a slight fall in the number of cases within the school community. Can I take this opportunity to thank parents/guardians for their understanding in taking their child(ren) for a PCR test when required or by keeping them at home when unwell.

As part of our aim to keep everyone safe, the guidance on face masks/covering for schools has been amended. As a result, **with immediate effect** we will be returning to asking all parents/guardians who enter the school site or drop off/pick up to wear a face mask/covering.

Despite the emergence of a new variant of COVID as previously stated from Monday 1st November, in line with national guidance school will continue to follow the information below unless anything changes –



Can I also please remind parents/guardians in line with medical guidance published yearly that pupils who are off school due to a Diarrhoea and/or vomiting bug that they need to remain off school for 48 hours since the last episode. School last week had to send home a small number of pupils who had returned to school early. Please do not be offended if the school secretary and/or class teacher phone you to obtain further information on your child(ren)s return to school.

Children in Need

On Friday 19th November, we celebrated Children In Need with a range of activities in school and many pupils wearing a wide range of Pudsey clothing/accessories. I am pleased to announce that school raised £240 pounds in the day and a further £60 with Nursery pupils and a small group of year 4/5 pupils raising money within the community. Therefore, a grand total of £300 has been raised and sent to Pudsey. A huge thank you to everyone for their donation.

School Dinners

Can I please remind parents/guardians that all school dinners now need to be pre ordered before 08.30am on the morning your child(ren) would like a school dinner. After that time, unless an emergency, we can only order pupils a packed lunch. Whilst school has tried to be lenient, the local authority has informed us that from tomorrow (Tuesday 6th December) we can no longer allow pupils to order during the registration period of the morning.

Mrs Halliwell and Mrs Thomas will be busy cooking school Christmas dinners this Thursday 9th December for Foundation Phase pupils and Thursday 16th December for Key Stage 2 pupils. A reminder also that on both Thursdays there will only be a packed lunch option available for anyone wishing to order a school dinner. Please note that this will NOT be shown on ParentPay, the system will show the full menu.

Dogs on the school yard

It has been brought to my attention that recently a number of parents/guardians have been bringing their dog onto the yard during the home time pick up routine. Can I please remind everyone that NO dogs are allowed on site at anytime throughout the school day even if they are being carried by their owner. This presents a serious Health & Safety risk to both pupils and other parents/guardians picking up. Therefore can I please ask with immediate effect that NO dogs enter the school premises. Thank you
