Dates for the Diary

When we return to school after half term there are two key events in the first week back. I would like to provide you with information in relation to both of these.

1st March 2023 – St. David's Day

As a school we shall be celebrating St. David's Day by holding our own Eisteddfod. Information in relation to this event and the competitions that pupils are able to enter will be sent out by Mrs Evans-Jones this week. On the day itself pupils are able to come to school in traditional Welsh costumes or wearing something red.

All families are invited to join us, and/or make a lantern at home to utilise during the parade. 3rd March 2023 – World Book Day

We shall also be celebrating World Book Day this week. As the proposed date for the postponed strike is the 2nd March, school have decided to move our World Book Day celebrations to Friday 3rd March. Children are welcome to come to school on this day dressed as a character from a book should they wish to do so. We shall be celebrating this event with school activities which will be shared with you via our digital platforms.

Drop off and Pick Up Time

Could I please take this opportunity to remind all parents about being mindful during drop off and pick up times. Whilst we appreciate that parking is extremely difficult around school can we please remind drivers of the following issues/concerns —

- Please DO NOT park on the yellow zig zag lines at any point throughout the day including after school
 when picking up from Dragons. The lines are there to provide a passing point and keep traffic moving.
- Please do not block the driveways of local residents both on Tanyfron Road and St. Albans Road.
- Please be mindful at the top of Tanyfron Road where the pavement comes to an end. Please ensure
 that parents/guardians have appropriate access to continue their journey in the safest possible
 manner.
- Please be mindful of where and how you park your vehicle and ensure all parents/guardians are able to continue on their journey in the safest possible manner.

I would also like to communicate to all parents, that should there be any issues arising from parking or access that is causing a health and safety issue during drop off and pick up times, please inform a member of staff in school.
