Dear Parents/Guardians

As we are fast approaching the end of the half term, can I please provide you with the following update of information:

Friday 9th February – Show and Share Afternoon

On Friday afternoon school shall open its doors from 1.30pm for parents to come into school to have a look at the teaching and learning that has been taking place this half term. Throughout the half term all children in school have been learning through our 'Take Action' topic. Each class has taken a pupil led path of interest within this topic and have lots to share and explain about what they have learnt. Our show and share afternoon will provide parents with an opportunity to have a look in classrooms and your child's books as I am conscious that this only tends to happen on parents' evenings twice a year. We are happy for parents to come at any time after half past one and stay for as little or as long as you like.
