Dear Parents/Guardians

Our annual sports day is planned in for this Friday 24th May. Please see the following information to allow the day to run as smoothly as possible.

Seedlings (Dosbarth Mrs Humberstone and Dosbarth Mrs Evans-Jones)

Seedlings sports day will begin at 9.30am. The children will participate in a variety of track and field events and the morning should run until roughly 11am. The gates to the field will be open from 9am should parents want to find their spot straight after drop off. There will be limited seats available for those who require a chair, but we ask if parents would kindly bring their own picnic blanket or camping/garden chairs to enable us to make full use of the slope on the field to give everyone a space where they can see. Should you be coming back for the afternoon session as well, please feel free to leave these things on the field in between.

Oaks (Dosbarth Miss Gabriel and Dosbarth Miss Burgin/Williams)

Oaks sports day will begin at 1.30pm. The children will participate in a variety of track and field events and the afternoon should run until roughly 3pm. The gates to the field will be open from 1.15pm. There will be limited seats available for those who require a chair, but we ask if parents would kindly bring their own picnic blanket or camping/garden chairs to enable us to make full use of the slope on the field to give everyone a space where they can see.

All pupils can come to school in their P.E. kit (Yellow T-Shirt, Black Shorts, School jumper/cardigan and pumps/trainers) in readiness for the day. Seedling pupils will be able to remain in their P.E. kit after their sports day has finished. Please make sure your child has a drinks bottle and anything they may need for the weather forecast that day.

As is always the case, the weather forecast is ever-changing and it is difficult to predict what weather we will have on the day, so let's keep our fingers crossed! I fully appreciate that parents may have organised time off work to attend on this day so the plan will be to push on through the elements unless there is torrential rain and thunderstorms.
